New Coarse Fishery at Hurston Lane, Storrington

In November, 1996 The Hampshire and Sussex Anglers Alliance were awarded a Lottery Sports Fund Award of £30,000 to help purchase and develop a disused trout fishing complex at Hurston Lane, Storrington, West Sussex.

The site was finally acquired in April 1997 and the aim of the Hampshire and Sussex Alliance was to create three ponds of differing sizes to cater for coarse angling requirements.

The first pond in the complex, known as the Tench Pond, is a general purpose fishery. This pond has been stocked with tench, crucian carp and rudd and there is a small head of common carp. Along one bank of this pond and adjacent to the carp park an area has been created and reserved for disabled anglers.

The middle pond is specialist earp water with fish up to 20lb in weight. Night fishing is allowed on this pond for the enthusiastic carp angler.

A 24 peg club match fishery has been constructed from the top pond and is available for competitions. This pond is stocked with rudd, bream, carp and perch.

The picturesque site covers some 4.5 acres and is bounded on one side by the tiny River Storr. The ponds are spring fed and the fish are healthy and grow well.

On the last Saturday in September the site was officially opened by well known broadcaster and author Bob James.

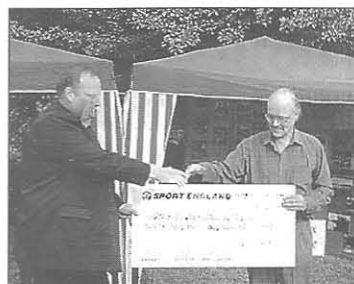
